

## **Order (District Administration Nuh)**

**Dated: 01-06-2020**

Whereas, as per notification dated 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2020 issued by Health Department, Govt. of Haryana has been declared nCOVID-19 an epidemic disease.

And whereas, the undersigned is empowered under Epidemic Disease Act, 1897 and section 144 of CrPc as well as Disaster Management Act, 2005 to issue directions regarding containment measures to prevent and contain the spread of nCOVID-19 disease, **I, Pankaj, IAS, District Magistrate, Nuh** do hereby prohibit the assembly of five or more persons in public place & regulate the operations of following activities in District Nuh till 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2020:-

### **Guidelines for Phased Re-opening (Unlock 1)**

**[As per Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-J (A) dated 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2020]**

#### **1. Phased re-opening of areas outside the Containment Zones**

In areas outside Containment Zones, all activities will be permitted, except the following, which shall remain prohibited.

The following activities will be allowed with effect from 8 June, 2020:

- (i) Religious places/ places of worship for public.
- (ii) Hotels, restaurants and other hospitality services.
- (iii) Shopping malls.
- (iv) Schools, colleges, educational/ training/ coaching institutions etc., consultations with States and UTs. State Governments/ UT administrations may hold consultations at the institution level with parents and other stakeholders. Based on the feedback, a decision on the re-opening of these institutions will be taken in the month of July, 2020.
- (v) International air travel of passengers, except as permitted by MHA.
- (vi) Cinema halls, gymnasiums, swimming pools, entertainment parks, theatres, bars and auditoriums, assembly halls and similar places.
- (vii) Social/ political/ sports/ entertainment/ academic/ cultural/ religious functions and other large congregations.

#### **2 National Directives for COVID-19 Management**

National Directives for COVID-19 Management, as specified below shall continue to be followed throughout the district.

- i. **Face coverings:** Wearing of face cover is compulsory in public places; in workplaces; and during transport.
- ii. **Social distancing:** Individuals must maintain a minimum distance of 6 feet (2 gaz ki doori) in public places. Shops will ensure physical distancing among customers and will not allow more than 5 persons at one time.
- iii. **Gatherings:** Large public gatherings/congregations continue to remain prohibited.  
Marriage related gatherings : Number of guests not to exceed 50.  
Funeral/ last rites related gatherings : Number of persons not to exceed 20.
- iv. **Spitting in public places** will be punishable with fine, as may be prescribed by the State/ UT local authority in accordance with its laws, rules or regulations.
- v. **Consumption of liquor, paan, gutka, tobacco** etc. in public places is prohibited.

*Additional directives for Work Places*

- vi. **Work from home (WfH):** As far as possible the practice of WfH should be followed.
- vii. **Staggering of work/ business hours** will be followed in offices, work places, shops, markets and industrial & commercial establishments.
- viii. **Screening & hygiene:** Provision for thermal scanning, hand wash and sanitizer will be made at all entry and exit points and common areas.
- ix. **Frequent sanitization** of entire workplace, common facilities and all points which come into human contact e.g. door handles etc., will be ensured, including between shifts.
- x. **Social distancing:** All persons in charge of work places will ensure adequate distance between workers, adequate gaps between shifts, staggering the lunch breaks of staff, etc.

**3. Night curfew**

Movement of individuals shall remain strictly prohibited between 9.00 pm to 5.00 am throughout the country, except for essential activities.

**4. Lockdown limited to Containment Zones**

- (i) Lockdown shall continue to remain in force in the Containment Zones till 30 June, 2020.



(ii) In the Containment Zones, only essential activities shall be allowed. There shall be strict perimeter control to ensure that there is no movement of people in or out of these zones, except for medical emergencies and for maintaining supply of essential goods and services. In the Containment Zones, there shall be intensive contact tracing, house-to-house surveillance, and other clinical interventions, as required. Guidelines of MoHFW shall be taken into consideration for the above purpose.

**5. Unrestricted movement of persons and goods:** There shall be no restriction on inter-State and intra-State movement of persons and goods. No separate permission/ approval/ e-permit will be required for such movements.

**6. Protection of vulnerable persons**

Persons above 65 years of age, persons with co-morbidities, pregnant women, and children below the age of 10 years are advised to stay at home, except for essential and health purposes.

**7. Use of Aarogya Setu**

(i) *Aarogya Setu* enables early identification of potential risk of infection, and thus acts as a shield for individuals and the community.

(ii) With a view to ensuring safety in offices and work places, employers on best effort basis should ensure that *Aarogya Setu* is installed by all employees having compatible mobile phones.

**8. Penal provisions:** Any person violating these measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under Section 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions as applicable.

**9.** Liquor shops, shall make barricading arrangement, use hand sanitizers and masks and also ensure social distancing in front of the shop.

**10.** Factories/Production sites/Commercial entities shall be allowed to have security and fire fighting personnel present.

**11.** Xen, HSAMB, DMEO, DFSC and All Secretary, MC's/Market Committee shall ensure that there is strict check in any hoarding/rise of retail price.

**12.** The Superintendent of Police, Nuh shall direct all SHO's for strict implementation of the restrictions.

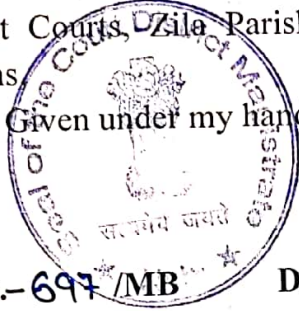
**13.** If there is a doubt about as to whether a service or establishment is essential or not, the District Magistrate, shall give a final decision on the same.

14. DETC, all SHOs, JD DIC, Secretary MCs, DEO/DEEO, BDPOs and other concerned departmental officers are directed to ensure compliance of orders.  
**All SDM Cum Incident Commander shall be overall incharge in their areas & shall supervise compliance of these orders. Tehsildars & Naib Tehsildars are authorized to report violatios.**

Failure to obey these orders shall be punishable under section 188 of I.P.C with punishment of serves fine and imprisonment.

In view of requirement of the situation which has become emergent, this order, is being passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public through the press and publicity van of public relations department and by affixing copy at notice board of District Courts, Zila Parishad, Sub Divisions, Tehsils, MCs, Panchayat Samities, Police Stations.
