

## YoY (Q223 vs Q222): Staffing industry grew at 20% YoY

- The markets are stabilizing with new employment growth as witnessed with a continued robust demand across sectors except IT.
- Nett headcount growth for staffing Industry (represented by ISF members) in the last 4 qtrs, has grown at 2.32 lakhs indicating significant new employment demand.
- General Staffing, that is employing from sectors like ecommerce, retail, manufacturing, BFSI, hospitality witnessed a very high demand.
- IT Staffing witnessed cautious approach as projects usually come to a close in this Qtr and also from the impact of global developments.

### Q223: QoQ Staffing industry grew at 6 %

- Q223 (July- Sept 2022) jumped
  +0.5% up from Q122
- ISF members have provided employment to appx 78K new job seekers in Q2 23.



General Staffing industry contributed with new employment growth at 7.3% growth in Q223. It was witnessed that Q2 23 had a +0.3% growth higher than previous Qtr with New Employment Growth

#### >>

ISF members added **2.24 lakhs new** employment across General staffing roles in last rolling YoY. There was ~77K new employment generated in Q2.

General Staffing Industry was primarily driven by demands from FMCG, Ecommerce, Manufacturing, Retail, Logistics, Banking, Hospitality, Tourism, Insurance, Infrastructure etc.


IT Staffing industry is very closely maintaining its employees across projects, as the YoY new employment growth is at **15.8%** from previous quarters.
