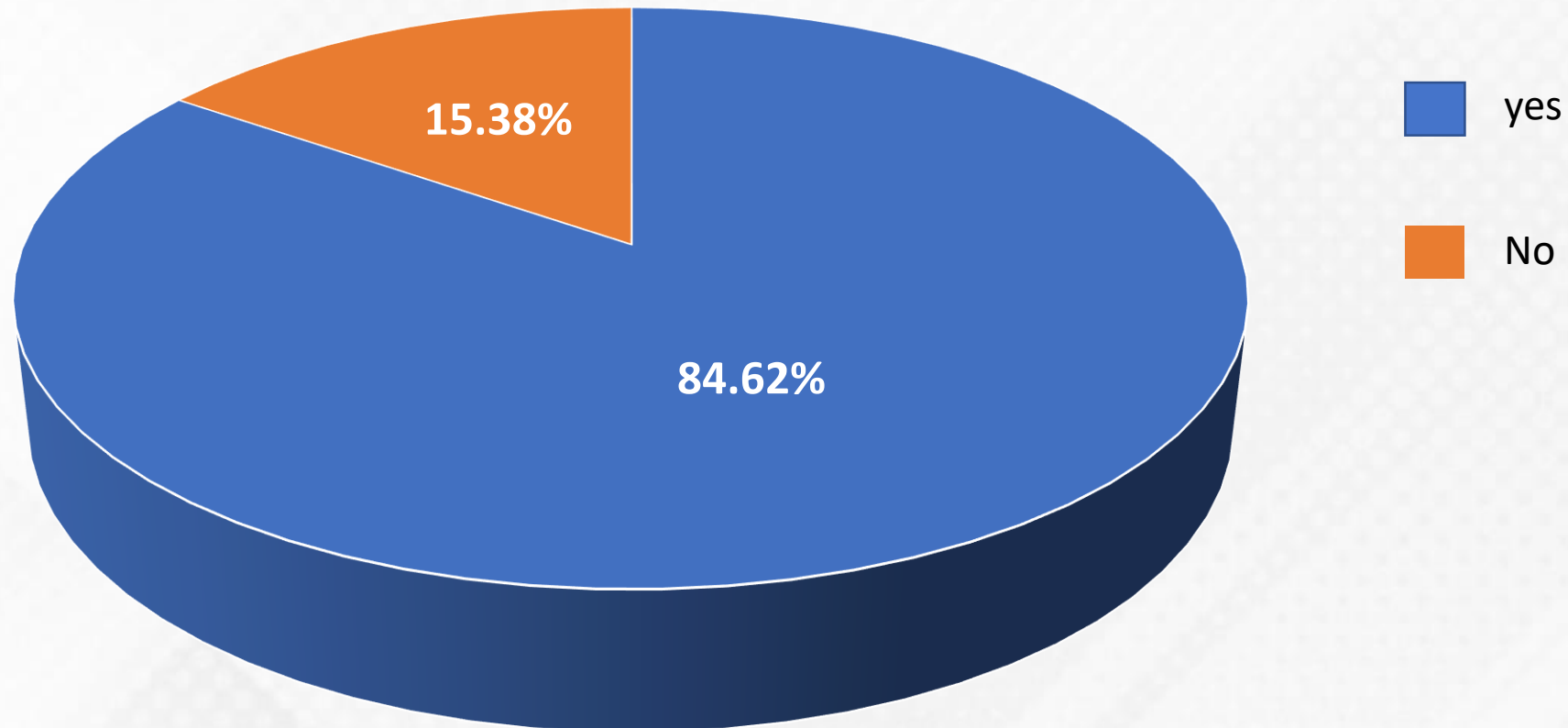

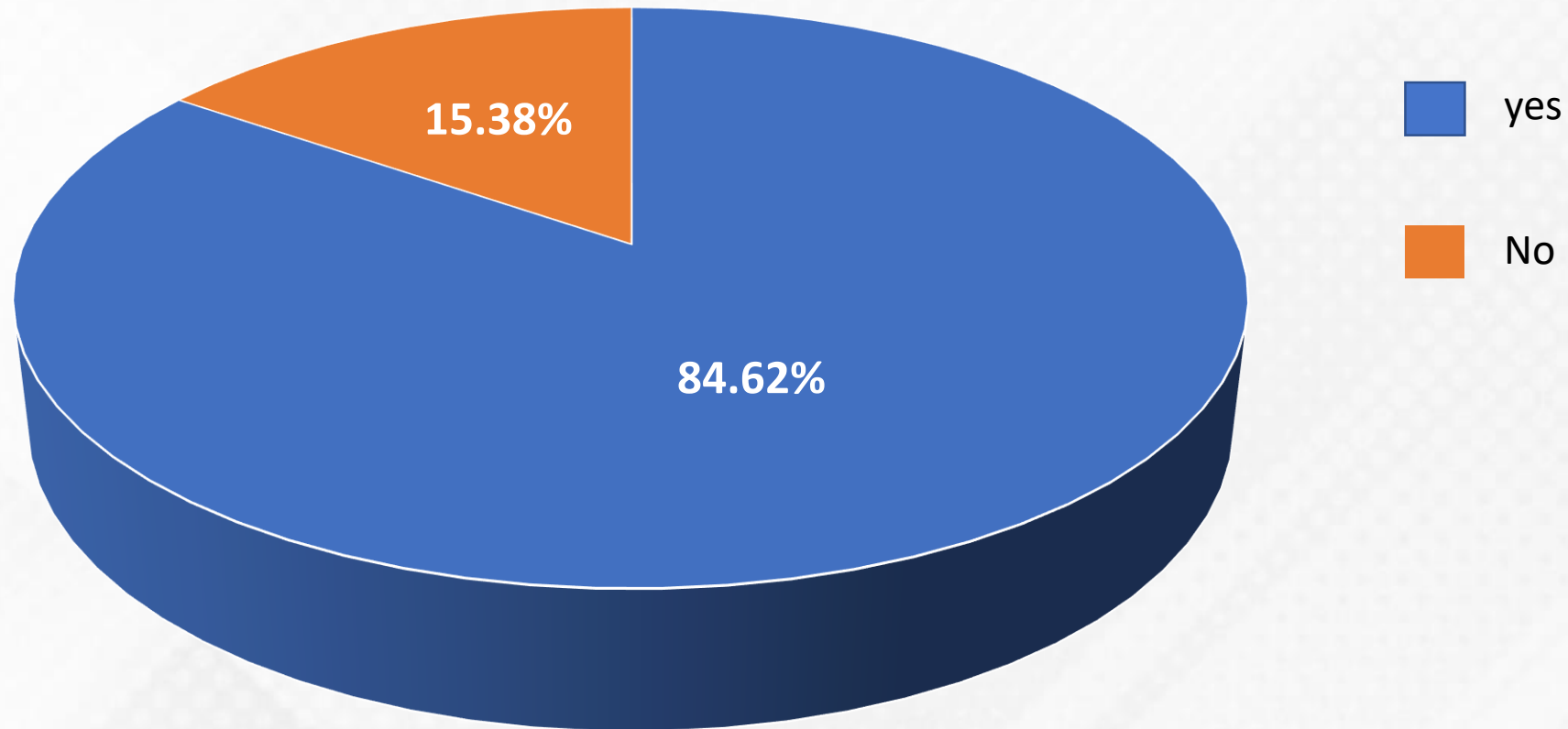

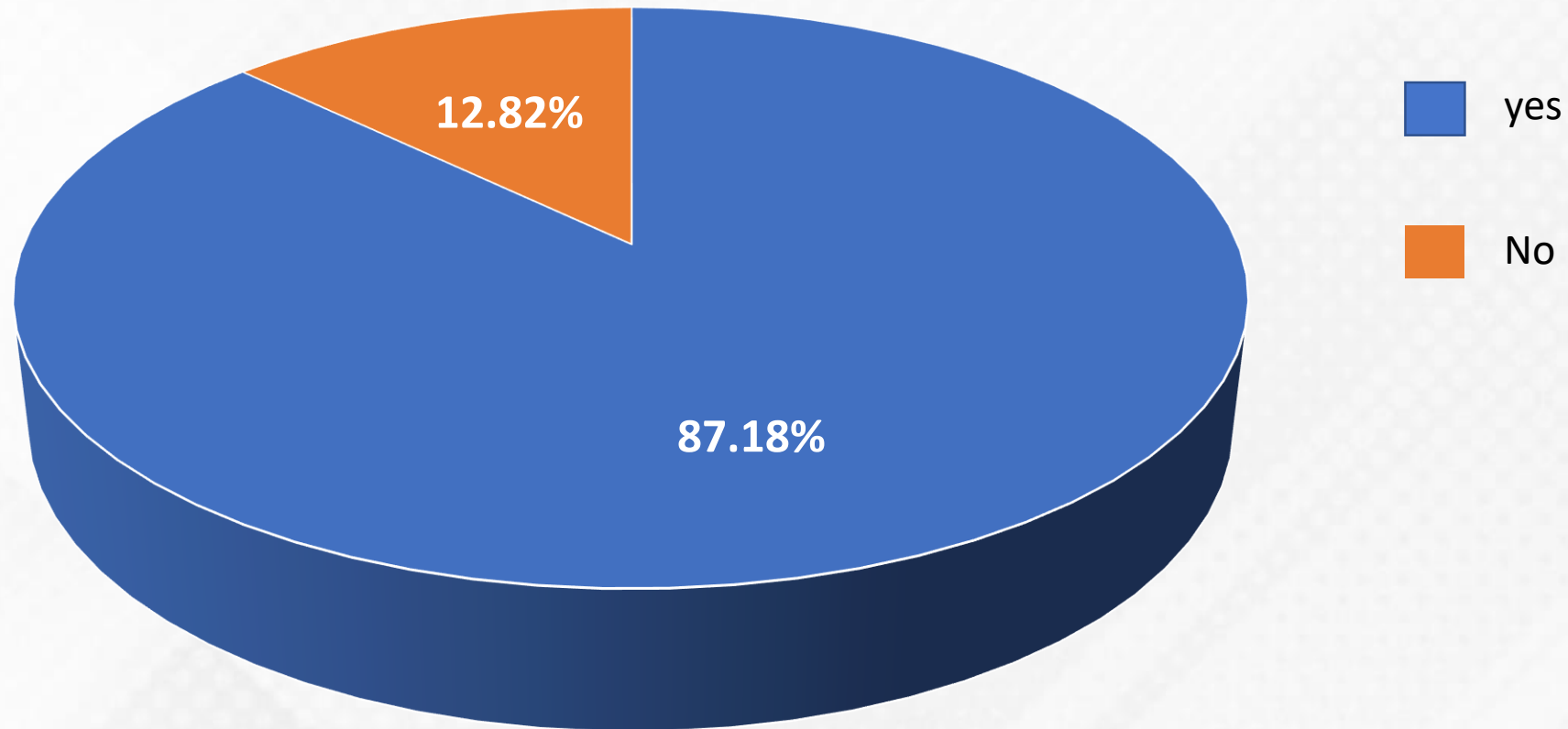
1) Does India Inc. really think that the free vaccination drive arranged by government will actually help them give their employees a safe and normal office environment?



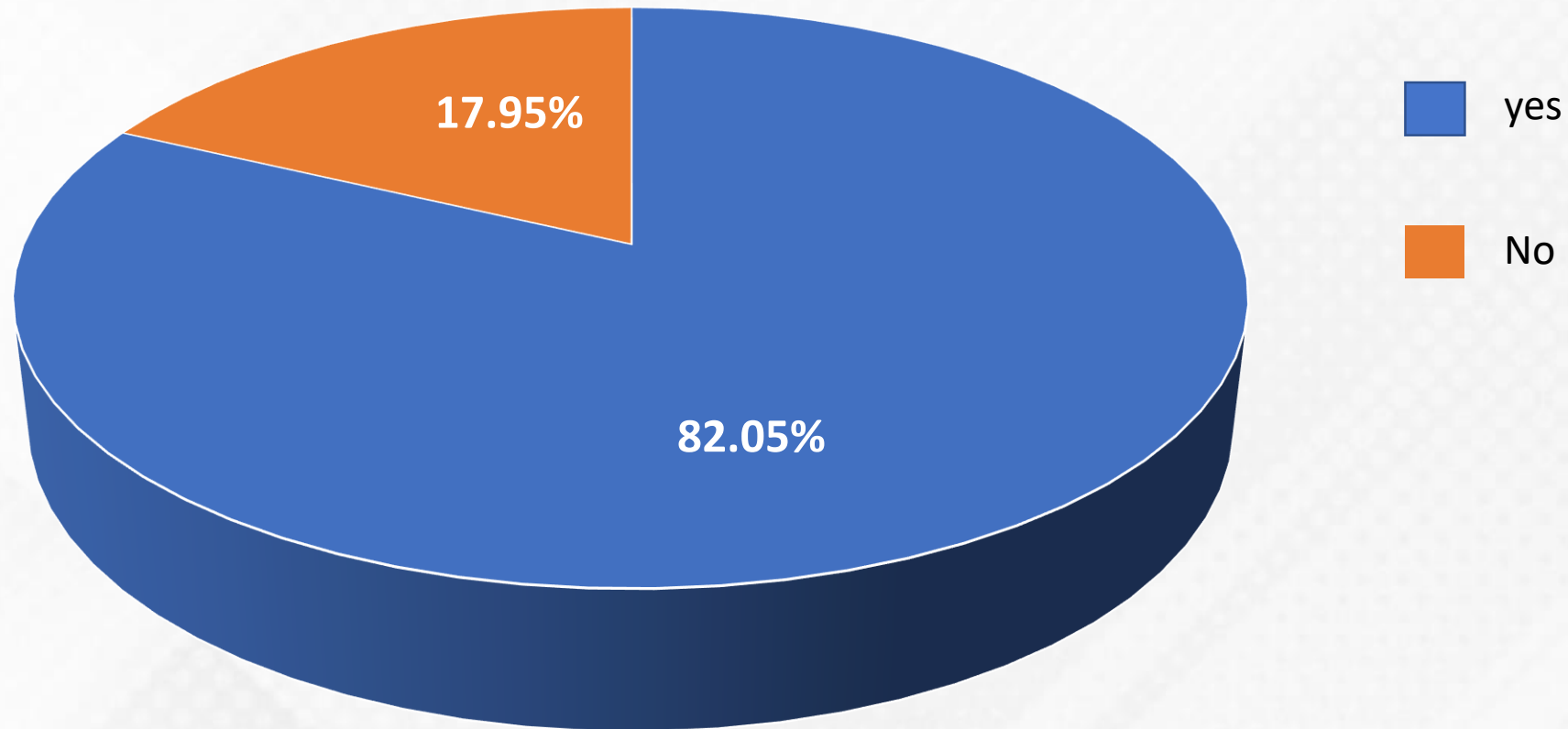
2) Will the free vaccination campaign ensure a revival of the unemployment scenario or opening of the markets?
